Upcoming Work Notice!

We wanted to give you a heads up about some upcoming work that may impact access to your driveway or business in the coming weeks:

- **Starting Monday, July 18th**—Concrete curb and gutter will start to be installed along 2nd Street, 3rd Street, Midland Avenue (from 1st Street to 4th Street). Once new concrete is poured, either the curb and gutter at the end of your driveway or your concrete driveway apron, we really need to keep vehicles off for seven days. This time will allow the concrete to cure and develop it's full strength. If you know that you will need to get vehicles, boats, trailers, or campers out of your driveway before the concrete work is done, please do that this weekend and find an alternate location to park temporarily. During the working hours, we need to avoid vehicles parked along the edge of the roadway so that concrete trucks and the contractors can perform their work.
 - ⇒ If you live or work along the east/west alleys between 1st Street and 3rd Street you will see the Contractor preparing for and pouring the center concrete valley gutter. Once poured, we will need to close the alleys off to traffic to allow for proper cure time.
- **Starting the Week of July 25th**—If you have a business along the east/west alleys between 3rd Street and 6th Street, you will see the pavement being removed within the next two weeks, to begin storm sewer installation and reconstruction of the alley. If you have delivery concerns or access concerns please continue to coordinate with Jarred (320.380.1689) so we can try to minimize impacts to your business.
