

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof a SPECIAL meeting of the Municipal Canvassing Board in and for the City of Albany, Stearns County, Minnesota, was called to order by Mayor Daron Gersch at 6:00 o'clock in the evening on Wednesday, November 12, 2014, in the Council Room at 400 Railroad Avenue for the said City.

Other Council members present were: Councilor John R. Harlander, John Greer, and Laurie Dingmann. Councilor Tom Kasner was absent.

Tom Schneider, Clerk/Adm., was present for the meeting and the following students from Albany High School: Kalley Bardson, Alexandra Schiffler.

Mr. Schneider informed the Board that the State, General and Municipal Election held on Tuesday, November 4th went very well with no irregularities. Mr. Schneider noted that the election judges did a wonderful job and the City Hall Polling Place was adequate for the number of voters in the building. Mr. Schneider informed the Board that there were 1,343 individuals registered as of 7:00 AM and that 55 individuals registered on Election Day. Mr. Schneider presented to the Board the following final election results which include the final absentee vote tallies from Stearns County:
